IMPORTANT NOTES

VISA - A VISA is required for travel to India. Travellers can apply online for an Electronic Travel Authorisation to avail of the VISA on arrival facility. For more information on this facility you can log on to <https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/> which is the official website of the Government of India, Ministry of External Affairs of India. If you are applying for any other category of VISA other than E-tourist VISA, we request you to contact a VISA service in your home country or the Indian High Commission or Consulate in your region.

INSURANCE - Travel Scope recommends that prior to commencing their journey, all travellers obtain an insurance that covers travel protection, trip interruption/cancellation and a health insurance that is comprehensive and covers for medical expenses, hospitalisation and repatriation etc. in the event of a medical emergency.

HOLIDAYS - In India, certain days are observed as national holidays. Some of these holidays are also observed as Dry Days where no alcohol is served in hotels or restaurants. There are other events such as Republic Day celebrations in January which restricts movement within Delhi during rehearsals and actual day of event on 26th January. We ensure that these are addressed at the time when we plan itineraries for our guests. Your travel designer will keep you informed in case any of these festivals or events co-incide with your travel itinerary.

WEATHER - The Indian sub-continent comprises different climatic zones. The weather can be different depending upon the regions you are travelling. During winters (especially from mid-December till end-January), we experience cold weather and fog in some parts of the country. This may also result in disruption of train or flight schedules. A detailed information on what to expect in terms of weather and along with a temperature chart is shared by Travel Scope in the pre-departure information. This helps travellers to understand the weather conditions and prepare accordingly for their trip.

MONUMENTS - While most monuments in India remain open for visitors throughout the week, some remain closed once a week, the specific day. For example, the Taj Mahal in Agra is closed on all Fridays! The day of closure varies from one monument to the other. Your travel designer at Travel Scope will keep you updated of such information while planning your guests itinerary.

WILDLIFE SAFARIS IN NATIONAL PARKS - Most Wildlife National parks in India remain closed for the monsoon season from July to September every year. Some re-open in October while others re-open from November. The National Parks in Central India remain closed for afternoon Safaris on Wednesdays as well as for full days on festivals such as Holi and Diwali. Most of the National Parks also open online bookings for Safaris well in advance. Confirmation of Safaris is always subject to availability at the time of booking a trip. Your travel designer at Travel Scope will keep you updated on all this information while planning a trip for your guests.
